


Invasive Alien Species

- Prevention
- Control
- Eradication



Winter Heliotrope *Petasites fragrans*

Prevention	 Most likely measure to be successful Least costly option Requires cooperation of a wide range of stakeholders
Control	 Containment of established species Damage-limitation measure Risk of accidental release/spread
Eradication	 Unlikely to be possible with an established species Very costly and complicated


