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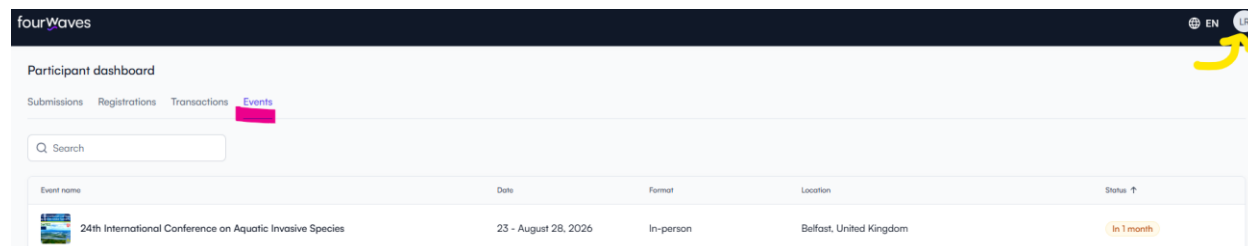
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How to access Fourwaves

- **OPTION 1:** through the browser of your computer, tablet, or mobile device -

- **OPTION 2:** NEW this year, you can download the Fourwaves app on your mobile device:

Activate your Fourwaves account

- Activate your account using the confirmation link that was issued when you registered for ICAIS or submitted your abstract, by going to the [Fourwaves login page](#) and clicking 'Forgot Password?' or by clicking 'Forgot password?' on the mobile app login screen. Be sure to use the email address you entered when you registered/submitted your abstract.
- **BROWSER ONLY:** Once logged into the account be sure you select 'Participant' from the top-right drop-down menu (click your profile icon), then ensure the 'Events' tab is selected.



- By clicking on the event, it will take you to the homepage. You can also access it in your browser here: <https://event.fourwaves.com/icaiss2026> (you must be logged in to see all of the pages).

IN A BROWSER

- You can see the conference schedule by clicking the ICAIS 2026 Schedule page on the top menu.

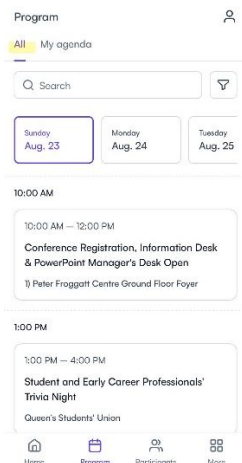

IN THE APP

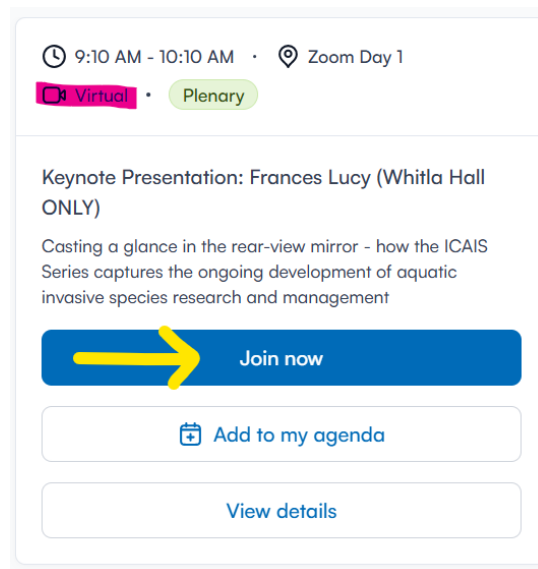
- Sign into your account

Accessing the livestreams

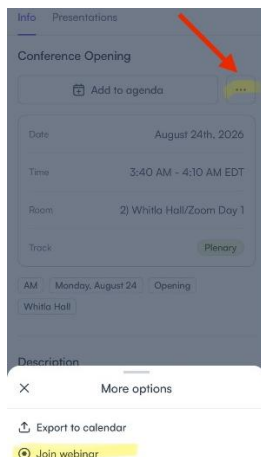
IN A BROWSER

- At ICAIS 2026, the plenary sessions will be livestreamed. The livestreamed sessions will be hosted on Zoom, and the link to access them is located on Fourwaves. Pre-recorded presentations may be available for concurrent sessions and posters should the presenter opt to upload them to the platform.
- The Zoom link for each livestream will be available by selecting the session in the schedule and clicking 'Join. now' This will prompt you to open the Zoom web app. Please have this downloaded prior to the event.

- Select 'Join Webinar'

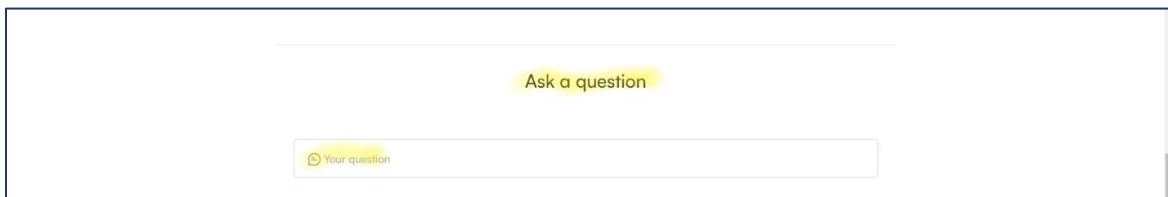


Accessing the recorded presentations

- All concurrent and poster presenters have the option to submit pre-recorded MP4 versions of their presentations and/or PDFs of their posters, and plenary speakers will be recorded live in real-time onsite. We will make every effort to ensure the plenary videos are available on Fourwaves by the end of that day (18:00 BST).
- There are two options to access concurrent session recordings where available:
 - 1) Go to the schedule in [Fourwaves](#) (must be logged in to view), click into the session of interest, and click on the title of the presentation. On this page, you will find additional information about the presentation, along with the video and/or PDF if available.
 - 2) Go to the 'Presentation' tab at the top of the Fourwaves webpage and click the presentation of interest. You can search on this page by title, abstract, or author.
- How to access the plenary session recordings:
 - Go to the schedule in [Fourwaves](#) (must be logged in to view) and click into the plenary session of interest.
- ***Please note that watching recorded presentations – both concurrent and plenary – is only available through an internet browser, ie. Chrome, Firefox, Edge, Safari, or Opera**

Interacting with the presenters

- There will be a Q&A period at the end of all concurrent session presentations (in-person only).
- For concurrent sessions and poster presentations, participants can ask questions through Fourwaves by following the process above to access the detailed presentation page. From here, type your question in the comment box at the bottom of the presentation page.
