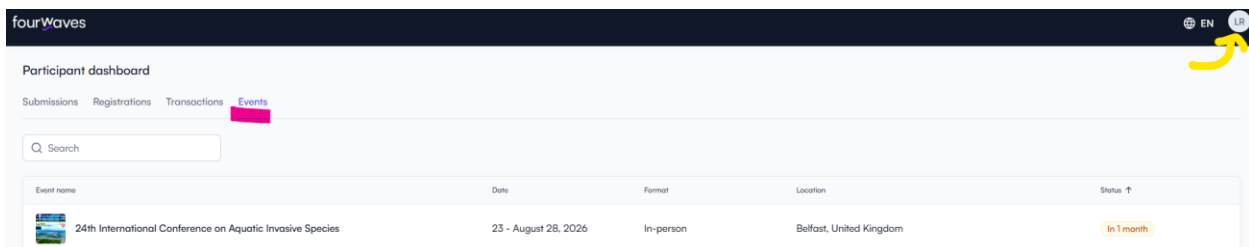

Activate your Fourwaves account

- Activate your account using the confirmation link that was issued when you registered for ICAIS or submitted your abstract, or by going to the [Fourwaves login page](#) and clicking 'Forgot Password?'. Be sure to use the email address you entered when you registered/submitted your abstract.
- Once logged into the account be sure you select 'Participant' from the top-right drop-down menu (click your profile icon), then ensure the 'Events' tab is selected.



- By clicking on the event, it will take you to the homepage. You can also access it here: <https://event.fourwaves.com/icaiss2026> (you must be logged in to see all of the pages).

Seeing the schedule

- You can see the conference schedule by clicking the ICAIS 2026 Schedule page on the top menu.

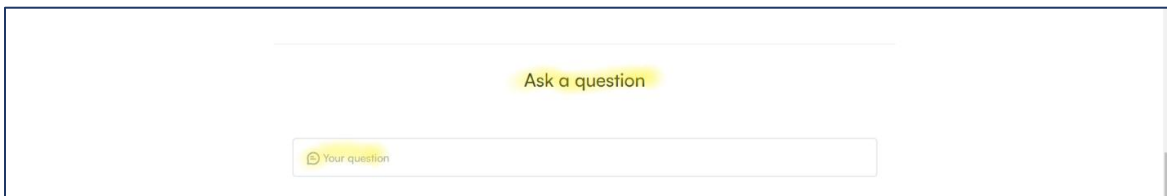

Accessing the recorded presentations

- All concurrent and poster presenters have the option to submit pre-recorded MP4 versions of their presentations and/or PDFs of their posters, and plenary speakers will be recorded live in real-time onsite. We will make every effort to ensure the plenary videos are available on Fourwaves by the end of that day (18:00 BST).
- There are two options to access concurrent session recordings where available:
 - 1) Go to the schedule in [Fourwaves](#) (must be logged in to view), click into the session of interest, and click on the title of the presentation. On this page, you will find additional information about the presentation, along with the video and/or PDF if available.
 - 2) Go to the 'Presentation' tab at the top of the Fourwaves webpage and click the presentation of interest. You can search on this page by title, abstract, or author.
- How to access the plenary session recordings:
 - Go to the schedule in [Fourwaves](#) (must be logged in to view) and click into the plenary session of interest.

Interacting with the presenters

- There will be a Q&A period at the end of all concurrent session presentations (in-person only).
- For concurrent sessions and poster presentations, participants can ask questions through Fourwaves by following the process above to access the detailed presentation page. From here, type your question in the comment box at the bottom of the presentation page.



- If you want to email a specific speaker or participant, go to the 'Participants' tab at the top of Fourwaves, select the person you want to connect with, and click 'Contact.' *Please note that the 'Participants' tab will be made available shortly before the event begins.
